Fabric Name Badge

With Paper Pieced Star

- Two (2) half-star paper piecing patterns, printed or traced onto your preferred foundation (<u>pattern link</u> or see graph at end)
- Off-White background fabric (W):

Cut
$$4 - 3'' \times 3''$$
 (Piece 1 & 4)

$$1 - 1'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}$$

Cut
$$1 - 1'' \times 3''$$

- Light Blue horizontal star points fabric (L):

Cut
$$2 - 2'' \times 2''$$
 (Piece 2)

- Dark Blue vertical star points and frame fabric (D):


Cut
$$2 - 2\frac{1}{2}$$
" x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (Piece 3)


Cut
$$4 - 1'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}$$


Flannel or thin batting or interfacing (whatever you like for additional stability) – @ 4" x 5"

Fabric marker or embroidery thread or preprinted fabric for marking names

Fastener (safety pin or ribbon for tab or ties or whatever other attachment you like)









NOTE-If not familiar with paper piecing, you may want to watch a paper piecing tutorial first.

- The half star paper pattern is a mirror image of the finished star, two copies are needed.
- Fabric pieces are positioned on the back of the pattern, stitching is done from the front along the appropriate lines.
- Piece1 is positioned good side facing out against the pattern back.
- Position Piece2 on top of Piece1, right sides together.

- the short star diagonal 1-2 line. Fold the paper back along the just sewn seam and trim any excess fabric to 1/4" seam allowance. Re-flatten the pattern and finger press the newest piece open.
- Repeat for Piece3, sewing along the vertical 1/2-3 line.
- Repeat for Piece4, sewing along the long star diagonal 3-4 line.








Unfinished half star size: 2½" wide x 2" long

- Square off any excess fabric along the outer dotted cutting line of the pattern.
- Make a second half star section.
- Position as shown and sew the two half star sections together.




Press seam open.

 Up to you if/when to remove paper pieces.



Unfinished star size: 2½" wide x 3½" long



- Use scant ¼" seam for all seams.
- Sew on background (W) side strip then bottom strip.




Unfinished size: 3" x 4"



For the outer frame, decide if you want straight or mitered corners and sew dark blue (D) strips on accordingly.

Unfinished size: approximately 4" x



NOTE - At whatever point in the process works for you, put NSQG vertically on the left background strip and your name horizontally on the bottom background strip via marker, embroidery, or printer.

- If desired, position any hang tabs or ties and tack in place.
- Trim the badge, flannel, and back to the same size.
- Layer the back and the badge, right sides together.
 Lay the flannel on top of that.
- You should now have a sandwich with the inside of the badge and wrong side of the back facing each other and flannel showing on an outer side.
- Sew all around with scant ¼" seam, leaving about a 1" opening along the bottom for turning.
- Trim corners, turn right side out, shape, and press.

- Close opening by hand or top stitch all around.
- Stitch in ditch inside blue border strips.
- If using a safety pin as a fastener, attach now.






