In this hands-on class, discover the secrets of embroifdery, trapunto, piping, couching and quilting by hand or machine to give your quilts that extra zing. Students will make several small studies or one large wall quilt using line in many sensitive and exciting ways. Slides and class examples will see you "line dancing" forever! www.rosaliedace.co.za.

At the April meeting, the group will explore different methods of making dimensional flowers. Noreen Graham will demonstrate how to use small gathered circles to make forget-me-not flowers and Kathy Kaplan will be demonstrating the use of ruching to make roses and daffodils. In May, Denise Isherwood will demonstrate how to make a small dimensional lily of the valley flower, dangling bluebells and a two-layered foxglove. Diane Linker will demonstrate how to make a charming ladybug.
