Invitational Quilt Exhibit - Marge Tucker



Marge Tucker is an international award-winning quilt artist and quilting instructor. Learning how to sew clothes from her mother, the first quilt she made was for friends expecting their first child over thirty years ago. “At that time, I didn’t know that quilting would become my passion and now my profession. I feel so fortunate to be able to share and continue the tradition of quilting with my

students.”

“I started with traditional pieced quilts but am now focused on abstract improvisational design in my work.

Diane was a prolific quilter with a passion for hand applique, English Paper piecing and intricate piecing.

Members were challenged to design and sew a small quilt using upcycled material from neckties and scarves. Each Entry was to be no larger than 80” in perimeter. Voting was held at the March 2025 NSQG Guild Meeting and the winners were announced. Ribbons for the winners are displayed on the winning quilts at the show. Connected by Threads 2025 Challenge
